Science LB - Tips!

Big Question:

What are some tips for preparing for and taking the ACT test?

Set the Stage:

Using this video from PBS Kids

https://net.pbslearningmedia.org/resource/plum14.sci.life.cooper/cooper-hunts-for-h2o/ 1 minute and 54 seconds, set the stage for the flashcard game below. And, yeah! Water is one strategy to use!

Activity:

Procedure: After the intro video:

- Ask what is the moral or that story? Well, believe it or not, water is one tool
 that you can use to help manage your ACT test taking strategy!
- Have kids work in pairs to work and talk through the flash cards in this lesson.
- Come back together after the pairs all get through the cards.
- Have a larger group discussion on these tips.

Note to Facilitator: After the large group share out, suggest that students add to these flash cards with test taking tips that they already use. Youngsters can also look up new skill on the Internet and add information that way.

Reflection

To communicate their observations: "I saw..."

To reflect on their predictions: "I thought...but then..."

To demonstrate test taking skills: "I liked..." or "loved..."
