BSB's FSCS Program Support (Tier III)

Full-Service Community Schools (FSCS) programs supported by BSB's Leverage grant (Tier III) will prioritize afterschool and summer learning to enhance the coordination, integration, accessibility, and effectiveness of services for children and families in high-poverty schools, including high-poverty rural schools.

FSCS programs encompass various projects, emphasizing comprehensive academic, social, and health services that significantly contribute to improved educational outcomes for children. The pipeline services, aligned with the four pillars of community schools, specifically highlight:

I. Integrated Student Supports

- Social, health, nutrition, and mental health services and supports
- Juvenile crime prevention and rehabilitation programs

II. Expanded and Enriched Learning Time and Opportunities

- Early childhood education programs
- Out-of-school-time programs for school age youth, including afterschool and summer learning
- Support for a child's education transitions
- Activities promoting postsecondary and workforce readiness

III. Active Family and Community Engagement

- Family and community engagement
- Community-based support for students

IV. Collaborative Leadership and Practices

Each community school receiving BSB Leverage grants will tailor these pipeline services to local needs, with a particular emphasis of BSB funding focused on efforts to fostering afterschool and summer learning.
