Building on insights from her best seller Whole Child, Whole Life, acclaimed educator and speaker Stephanie Malia Kraus will be headlining GetConnected 2024, Nebraska's Statewide Afterschool and Summer Learning Conference at the Younes Conference Center South in Kearney on September 27th 2024.



While a national talent, Dr. Kraus is no stranger to Nebraska – she is currently working closely with Nebraska 4H Extension leading a statewide professional development learning community helping equip Extension Educators with the tools they need to better serve the needs of today's youth. Building on this momentum, we will be distributing copies of Dr. Kraus' Whole Child Whole Life throughout the summer and will plan activities, including webinars and discussion groups, focused on this important topic as a lead up to GetConnected. Summer Entrepreneurship Opportunity!

Young Entrepreneur Institute (YEI) created the **Young Entrepreneur Pitch Challenge OST** to empower young people in afterschool and summer programs to flex their entrepreneurial mindsets by creating business ideas and pitching them. Problem-solving, empathy, communication, and creativity are just a few of the skills they practice by participating. Programs: Register by June 15, 2024!



- Students think of an idea for a service, product or community initiative (they don't need to start their business/idea).
- Students create a 30-to-90-second video of themselves presenting their pitch.
- Students can work alone or in groups of up to four.
- Enter videos via an online platform by July 15th, 2024.
- Entries will be judged on Creativity, Clarity, Persuasiveness and Overall Quality.

Program incentives include:

- A free Pitch Challenge Toolkit for facilitating five 1-hour lessons
- Free staff training and student workshops
- Registered programs with six or more students receive \$50 to celebrate with a pizza, donut, ice cream, or other party.
- Programs with a winning video will receive a \$50 gift card
- Every program will have a finalist for each age category with six or more students entering. Finalist entries receive \$60.

Last month, the Million Girls Moonshot Flight Crew - Olive, Isabella, Jamora, Aika, Caitlynn, and Neha (not pictured) - acted as media correspondents and youth advisory council members during the **National STEM Challenge** in Washington, DC.

Bring Literacy Games into Your Program with Clever Noodle!

 CVCC), and introduces a cutting-edge method of blending to accelerate reading and
 especially support struggling readers.

If you want to skip right into use, Nebraska afterschool programs are being offered games for \$22.50 (a 25% discount off retail price of \$29.95).
