- **Businesses & Individuals – McLean Beef, Jensen Lumber, Ace Hardware, and dedicated community volunteers**

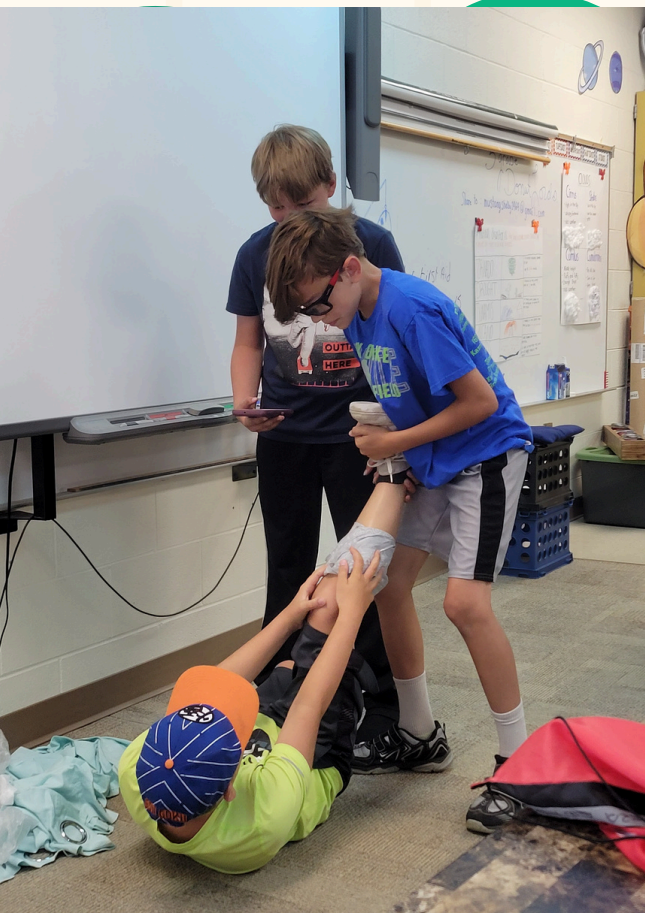




Additional Learning Opportunities

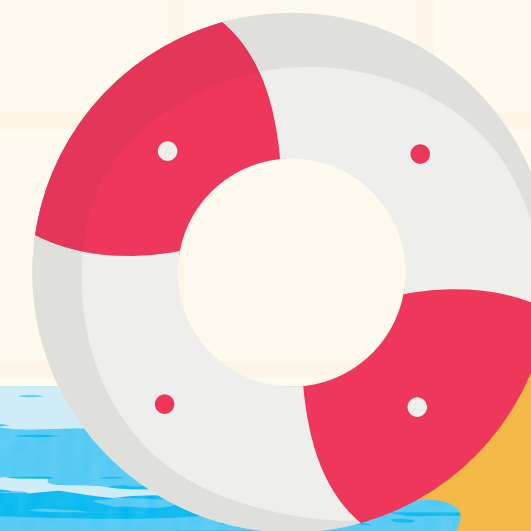
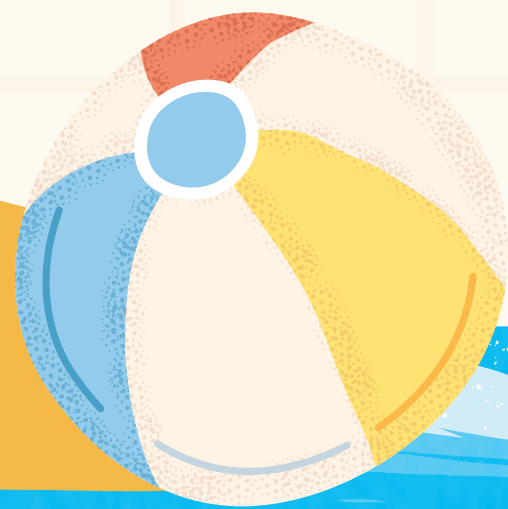
