Conservation Management MENTORS



Paid position to lead high school groups (3 students) for the Conservation Management Internship. Each group will travel Nebraska for two weeks (May 31 - June 13) learning from conservation experts and practitioners.

Qualifications:

- College student or recent graduate with interest or background (preferred) in conservation, natural sciences, environmental science, etc.
- Must be at least 21 years old.
- Demonstrated responsibility and ability to drive long distances.
- Subject to background check.

Job Description:

- Mentors will become temporary employees for the duration of the trip
- Mentors will be responsible for:
 - Overseeing trip experiences
 - Driving students
 - Engaging in hands-on field work alongside professionals across Nebraska and encouraging high school Interns to do the same
- Mentors needed for two-week session (May 31 - June 13, 2026) that will include travel across Nebraska.
 - Groups will spend 1-3 days at each location* to learn what conservation looks like at each site, learn how the professionals ended up in their careers, and to engage in hands-on conservation efforts.
 - Activities could include prairie restoration, invasive species removal, planting native flowers and so much more!
