

Reading LB - Quick Reading Game

Big Question:

How can we teach students reading comprehension?

Set the Stage:

Students will compete in a fast-paced reading comprehension game! They will read a prompt on the board and whoever buzzes in first must provide a summary of the paragraph

Activity:

Procedure:

- Have each student log into buzzin.live or give them a real buzzer
- Use the PowerPoint provided in Materials (add more prompts?) and display a paragraph on the board.
- Once a student has read the paragraph, they will buzz in and IMMEDIATELY give a summarizing sentence or two about the paragraph
- If the student is correct, his/her team is awarded a point.
- Once you have gone through all the prompts, the team with the most points wins!
